We wanted to share a few articles with you;

- 1) Attachment 1: NH Department of Environmental Service's (NHDES) proposal to establish new PFAS Drinking Water Standards; this article speaks to NHDES initiating rulemaking to establish Maximum Contaminant Levels (MCLs) and Ambient Groundwater Quality Standards (AGQS) for a variety of hazardous chemicals.
- 2) Attachment 2: Speaks to the Emerging Health Risks associated with Perfluorooctanoic Acid (PFOA's) and Perfluorooctane sulfonate (PFOS's); which are few of the PFC's found in the a few of the wells located on Pease back in April of 2014.
- 3) Attachment 3: Mortality Study of Workers Exposed to Perfluorooctanoic Acid
